Royal Academy: Charles I Exhibition

I am writing to inform you of an exciting opportunity to visit the Royal Academy in London. At present there is an exhibition called *Charles I: King and Collector*. This exhibition reunites the greatest masterpieces of Charles' collection for the first time since his execution. It includes over 100 works of art, ranging from classical sculptures to Baroque paintings, and from exquisite miniatures to monumental tapestries. In showing these works together, the exhibition demonstrates the radical impact they had at the time and sheds light on how they fostered a vibrant visual culture.

The trip will enrich your son/daughter's Civil War studies, and add to their understanding of the culture of Charles' court and its international links in the 1630s. This is an important element of their A Level specification, so should prove to be very profitable.

Tickets are usually £20, but we have secured them for nothing. However, this is dependent on the number of students attending being at least 10. The only cost, therefore, will be a train ticket into London and any food they wish to purchase.

The trip will take place (depending on numbers) on Monday 19th March, leaving at 11am, and returning by 5.15 at the latest.
