Dear Parents and Students

We are looking forward to welcoming all of Year 12 back after the half term break, once their external and internal exams finish. Many students have already been attending their BTEC and Applied Science lessons, but all students should be in school on Monday 4th June. Students should attend an assembly at 8:45 am in the Ritchie Hall, and their lessons will recommence at 9.00 am.

Lessons will begin to focus on the next stages of the course and on making the transition to Year 13. As outlined in our previous letter, we will also begin on our Destinations Programme which aims to guide and support Year 12 students as they begin to plan their futures post-18. Accompanying this letter, you will find an outline of the programme for the remainder of this term.

The two trips are described below and a complete outline for the destinations programme can be found at the end of this letter.

Thursday 21st June (morning) – visit to a Career Show which will be held at Peterborough Showground (10.00am departure). This will provide an opportunity to meet employers from a diverse range of companies, to discuss employment and apprenticeship opportunities available for those students with A level and BTEC qualifications.

Friday 29th June (morning) – visit to UCAS Higher Education Convention, which, this year, is to be held at Bedford University (8.45am departure). This event provides a wonderful opportunity for students to gather information about Universities. Over 200 Higher Education Institutions are present and all are keen to talk to prospective students.


Refreshments will be available to purchase at both venues, but students may wish to bring a packed lunch.
